Justin Mohamed is the Commissioner for Aboriginal Children and Young People and a proud Aboriginal man of the Gooreng Gooreng nation, near Bundaberg in Queensland. Justin has dedicated the past 28 years to working towards building a strong and healthier nation for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people.

Justin believes that better health is clearly linked to the positive outcomes of reconciliation and that better health for his people will build stronger education and employment outcomes, financial security, social participation and respect.

Prior to his role with the Victorian Government Justin was CEO of Equity Health Solutions, CEO of Reconciliation Australia, Justin chaired the, National Aboriginal Community Controlled Health Organisation, The Victorian Aboriginal Community Controlled Health Organisation, and was Co-Chair of the National Health Leadership Forum. He has also been the director of the Academy of Sport, Health and Education, based at the University of Melbourne's Shepparton campus, and CEO of Rumbalara Aboriginal Co-Operative.

Justin has also held positions on multiple community, state and national working groups, committees and boards. Justin continues to be a Director of Kaiela Institute and Co-Chair of Cricket Australia's National Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander Advisory Council.
