- Based on findings of a small pilot, design and development of a project to improve primary health care professionals understanding of eye health and vision care
- Build relationships with Victorian Primary Health Networks to support implementation of a prevention of vision loss model
- Liaison and collaboration with the Department of Health in establishing and running the project
- Collecting data, analysing and evaluating the PHN Implementation project.
- Supporting other Vision Initiative health promotion projects.

This position works as a senior member of the Vision Initiative team and is responsible for delivering high level, strategic projects and partnerships, and health promotion activity for the Vision Initiative. This role reports to the Vision Initiative Program Manager.

- Experience working within or alongside PHNs.
- Experience in establishing engagement programs and delivering agreed outcomes.

- Sound understanding of health promotion principles.
- Sound understanding of the social determinants of health.
- Experience in cross-organisational engagement to progress goals.
- Strong understanding of project management and evaluation principles and tools.
- Experience communicating with health professionals.
- Experience using online project management tools.

- Excellent written and verbal communication skills.
- Strong relationship management skills.
- Problem solving skills and the ability to identify and professionally deal with issues as they arise.

- Analytical and research skills with the ability to interpret data to translate into health promotion activity.
- Excellent time management skills and the ability to manage multiple tasks to timelines.
